Kinnect has expanded our partnership with public children services agency (PCSA) teams to continue enhancing kinship practice across the state. Search, Engage, Explore, Kinnect (SEEK) trainings focus on intense family search and engagement (FSE) values and strategies. These strategies empower families and produce lasting results, connecting young people with their families, kin, culture, and communities. SEEK trainings also support PCSA teams in FSE technology applications, including search tools such as Accurint and social media, as well as genogram building through GenoPro and the use of Connect Our Kids. All PCSA staff are invited to attend these innovative trainings, including direct front-line team members, supervisors, and administrative teams.

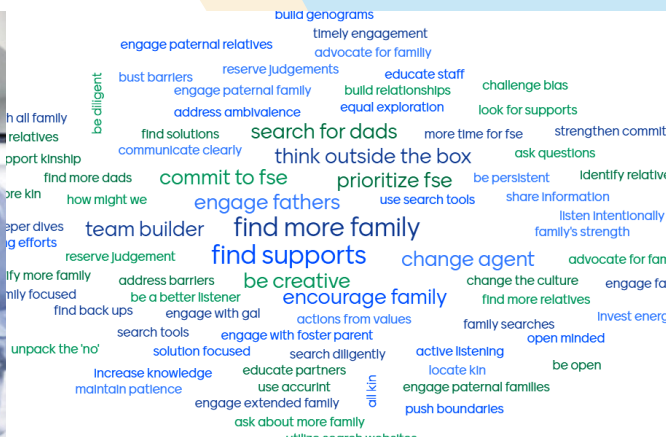
### Post Surveys: 339
